## **Registration**

• In-order for us to register your Step Up for Students (SUFS) Scholarship with our school, you must have an acceptance letter from The Bilgrav School

• You must have your award letter from Step Up for Students when you call/email.

### **Tuition Payments**

• Please contact Carla at (561) 619-8838 or email <u>Carla@Bilgravschool.org</u> to verify your monthly payment amount.

### **Check Endorsement**

• Once your check has arrived you will be contacted via email and/or phone.

• You must come in and endorse your check in a timely manner.

• All checks must be endorsed within seven (7) business days from the time you have been contacted. Your account will be assessed with a \$25 late fee should you fail to endorse your check within seven (7) business days.

• Checks must be endorsed only by the person whose name is on the check.

• Checks cannot be sent home.

• The scholarship funds are collected on a quarterly basis. To view your SUFS disbursement schedule please login into your account.

#### <u>Attendance</u>

• SUFS contacts The Bilgrav School every quarter to verify attendance and tuition payments.

• The Bilgrav School must verify that your child has at least 95% attendance and you are making your monthly payments in a timely manner, in-order to keep your scholarship in good standing. Please keep this in mind when making decisions regarding vacations, sick days and monthly payments. Being delinquent on your account may jeopardize your scholarship.

• Each family is responsible for all other tuition payments and fees (i.e., Registration Fee, Activity Fee, Re-enrollment Fee, uniforms, etc.)

### Scholarship Renewal
